

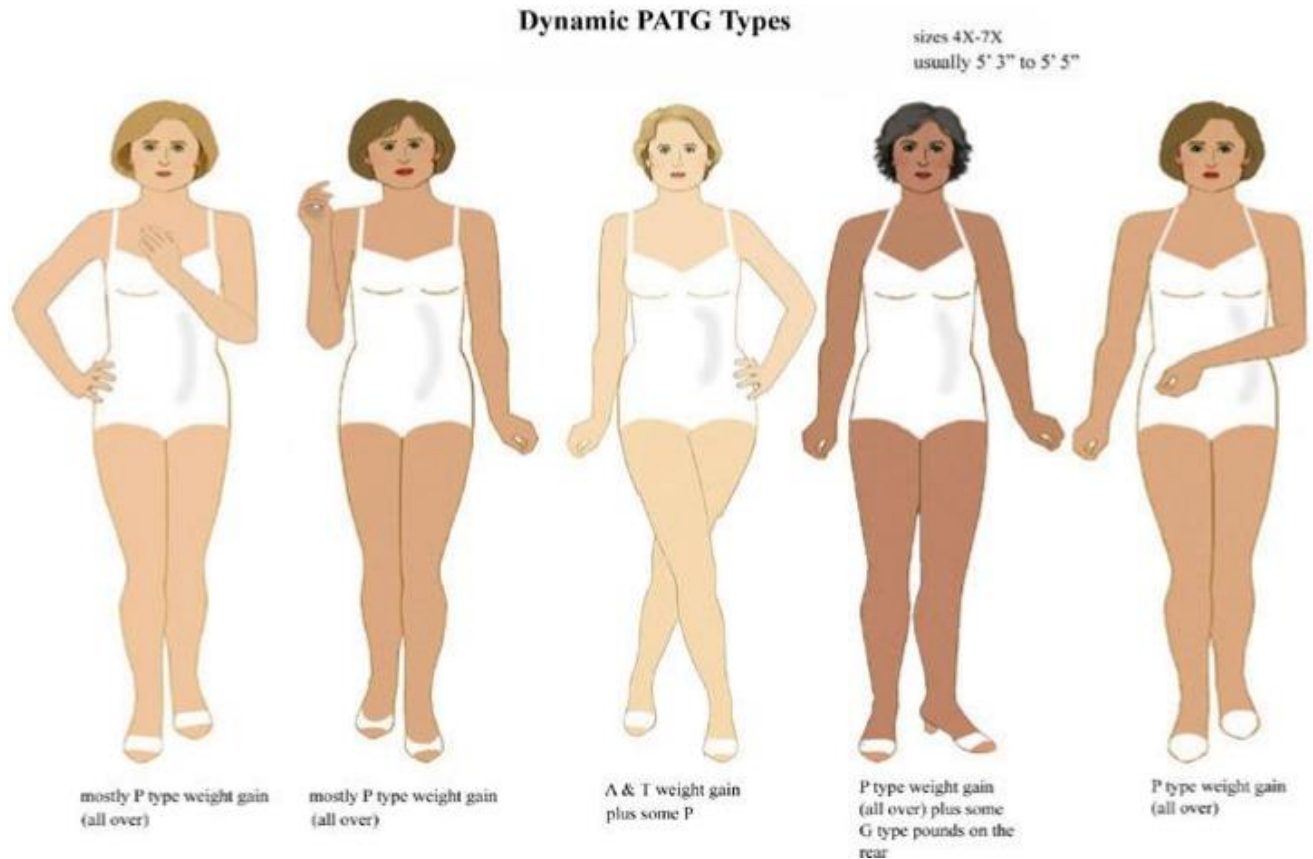
**GC:**

owns most of Gamine, if 2d place belongs to Natural we get a more rectangular-figured-GC, if Dramatic and Romantic occupies 2<sup>nd</sup> place – we get a more hourglass-figured-GC. Also aging then would be influenced either by Natural’s aging, or by R&D’s.

Wrinkled type of aging gets combined with one or another of these, but in a less form than pure types and just 2 types are mixed, so it becomes more balanced for GC.



There are no aged GC yet to show... but something like that:



Rectangular GC (2 most left figures) gains weight mostly as Gamines – all over.

But it also can happen to a more balanced, X-shaped ones, alone (the most right figure) or together with:

- Natural&dramatic’s weight gain => add at the chest, upper back, bottom tummy, and/or waist (figure in the middle).
- romantic’s weight gain => add at hips-thighs-butt and become more pear-shaped (second to right figure).

Finishing touch:

Minimalism suits only to aged Dramatics, others needs attracting attention (bright or big/or both together) jewelry (just check your lookbook and introduction if you need to accent arms/to have an accent around hips, so you can or can not wear the bracelets
